Overview

The ZENA™ Wireless Adapter is a multi-function USB wireless adapter that connects USB-equipped desktop or notebook computers with Microchip wireless products for development or application uses. As a development tool, the ZENA Wireless Adapter can be used as a protocol analyzer or as a diagnostic tool. It can also be used to connect the computer as a wireless node to the network for application uses. The ZENA Wireless Adapter can perform various functions and each function can be programmed into the adapter using the built in USB boot loader.

Depending on the frequency and device type ZENA Wireless Adapter can be ordered, the package includes one of the following:

- ZENA Wireless Adapter – 2.4 GHz MRF24J40 (AC182015-1)
