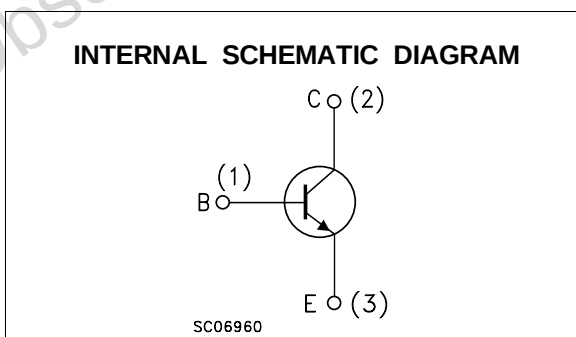

The BUT11A is a silicon Multiepitaxial Mesa NPN transistor in Jedec TO-220 plastic package, particularly intended for switching application.

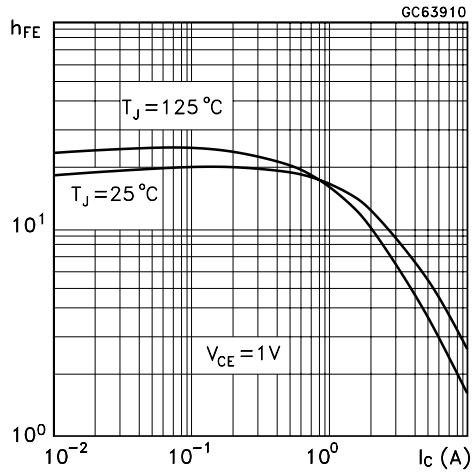

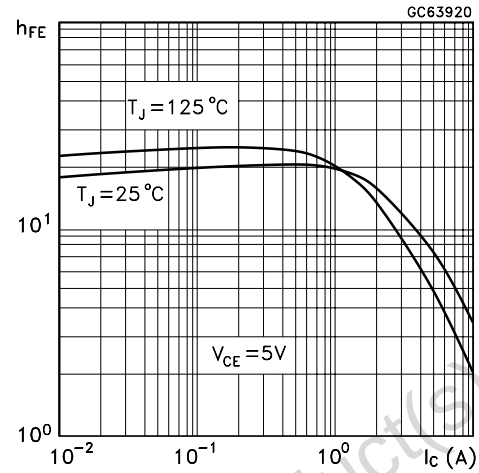

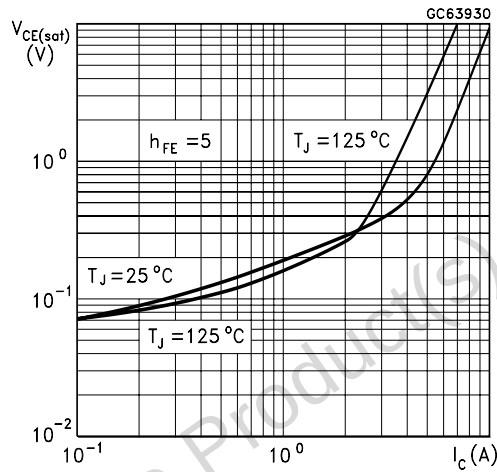
DC Current Gain



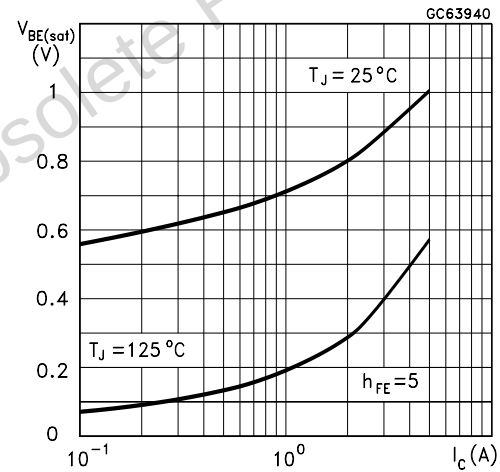
DC Current Gain



Collector-Emitter Saturation Voltage

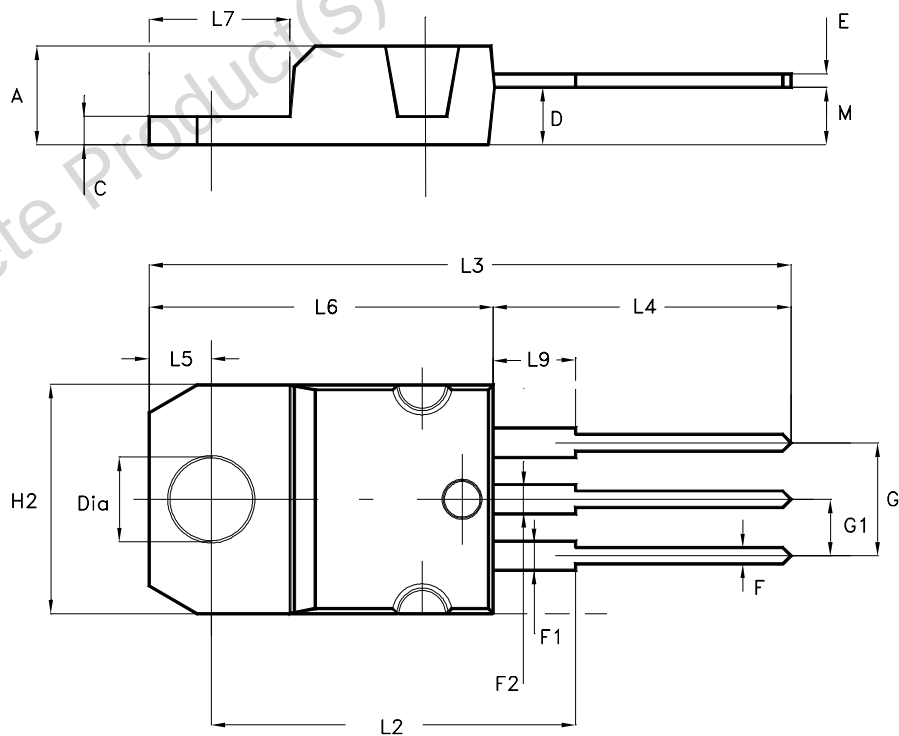


Base-Emitter Saturation Voltage
