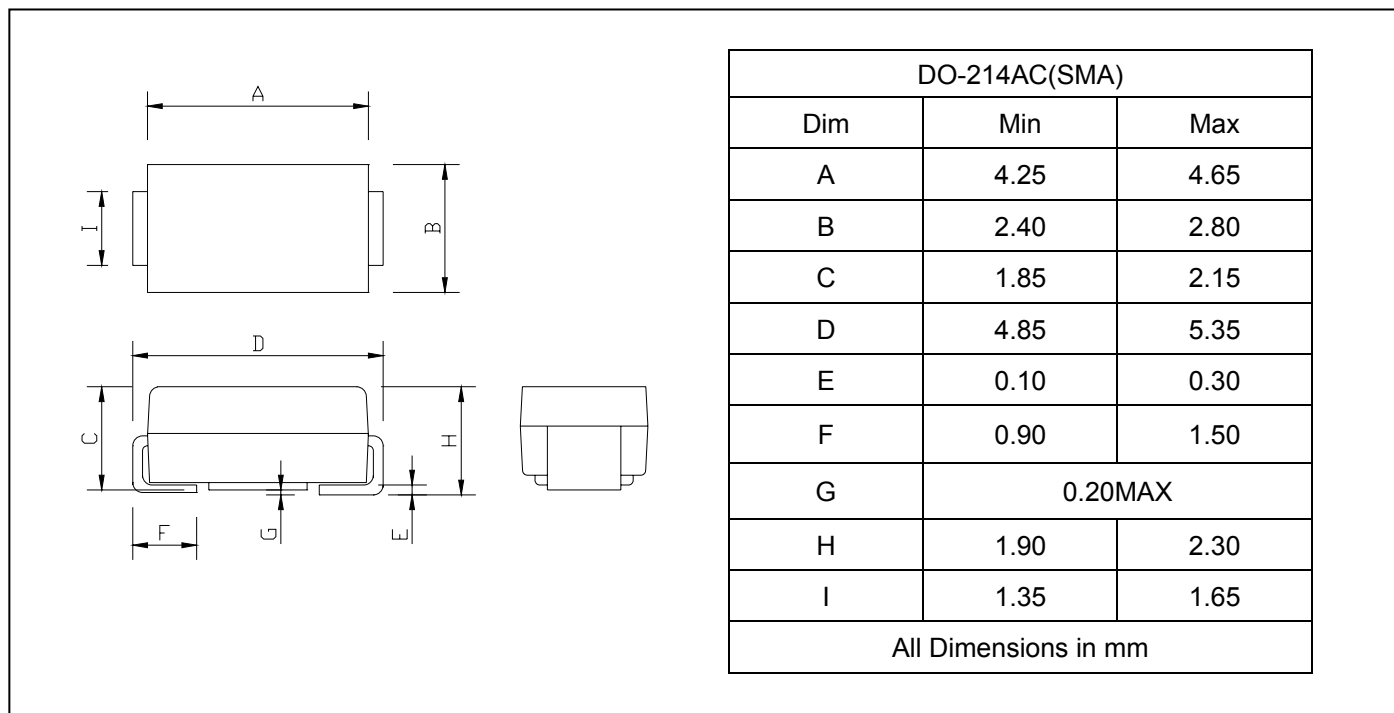

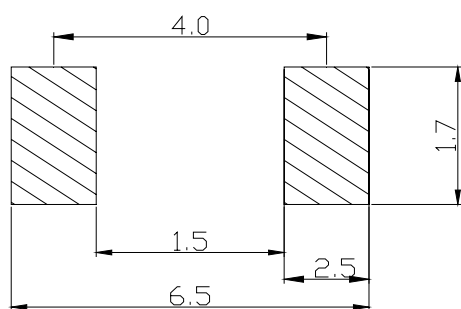

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FIG.1 – FORWARD DERATING CURVE

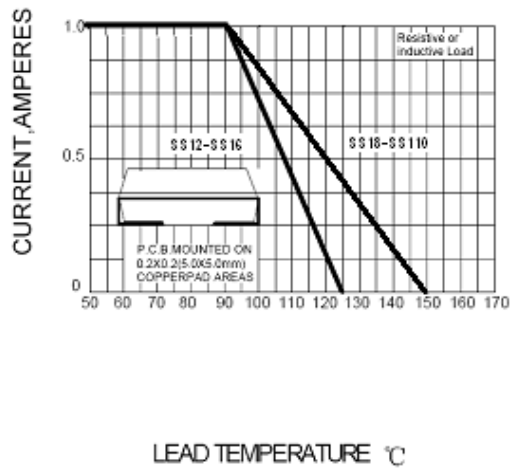


FIG.2– PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT

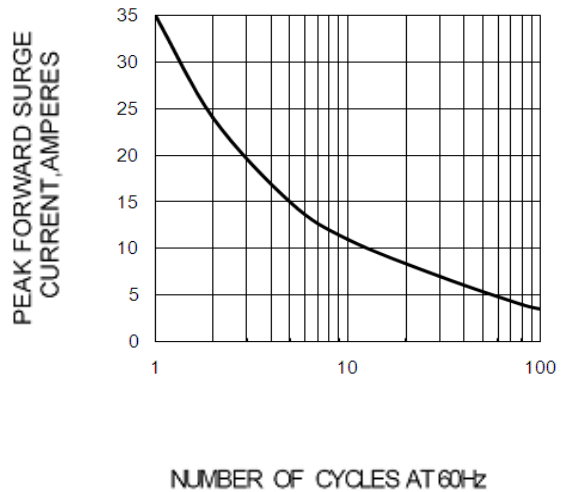


FIG.3 – TYPICAL FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

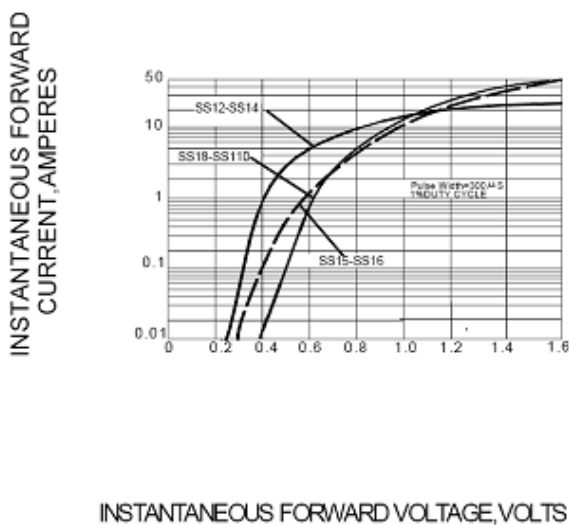


FIG.4 – TYPICAL REVERSE CHARACTERISTICS
