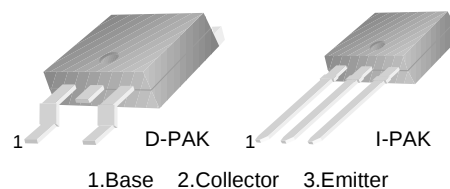

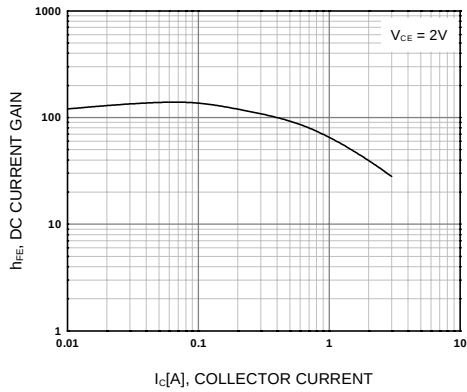


Figure 1. DC current Gain

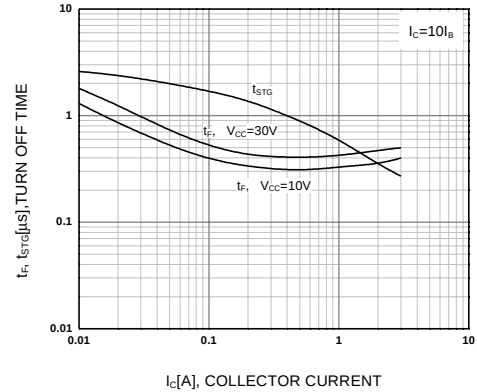


Figure 2. Turn Off Time

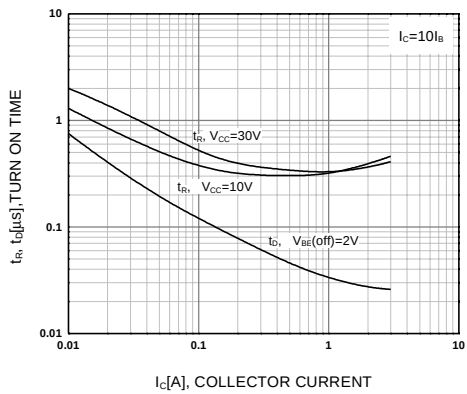


Figure 3. Turn On Time

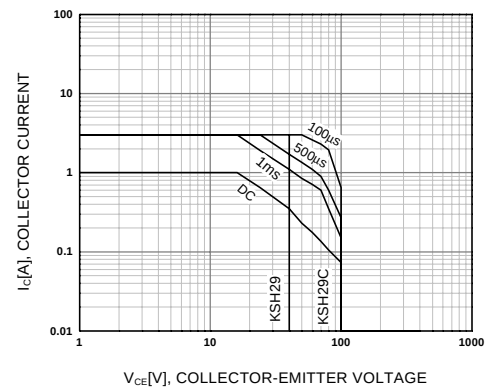


Figure 4. Safe Operating Area

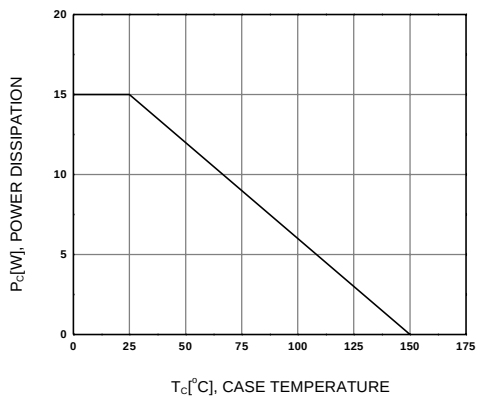
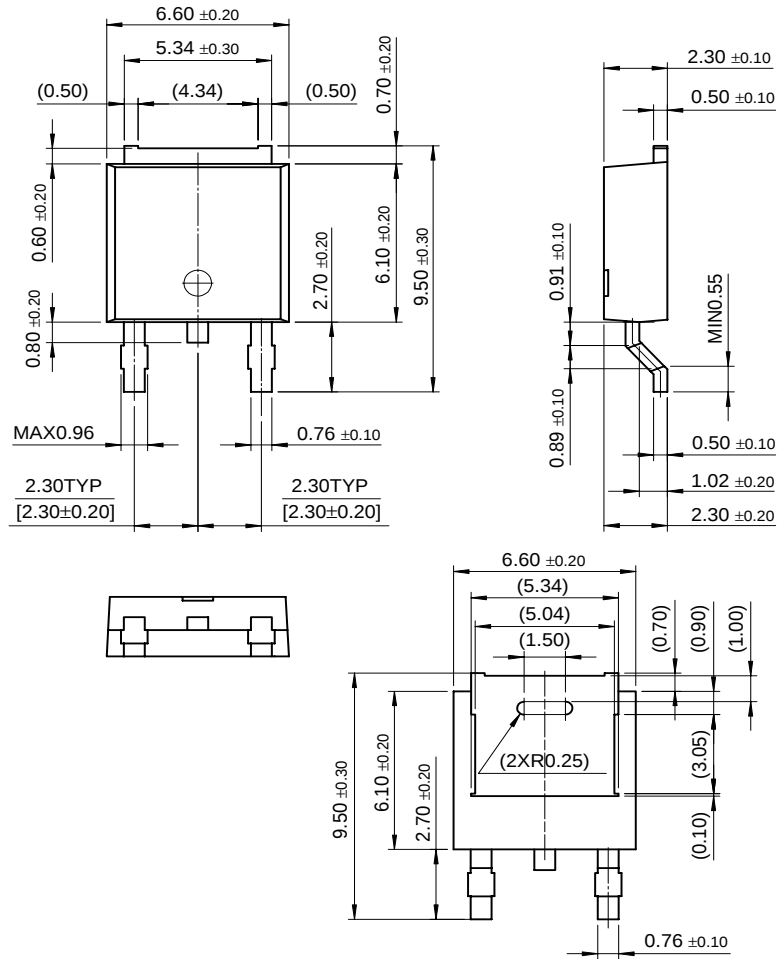


Figure 5. Power Derating

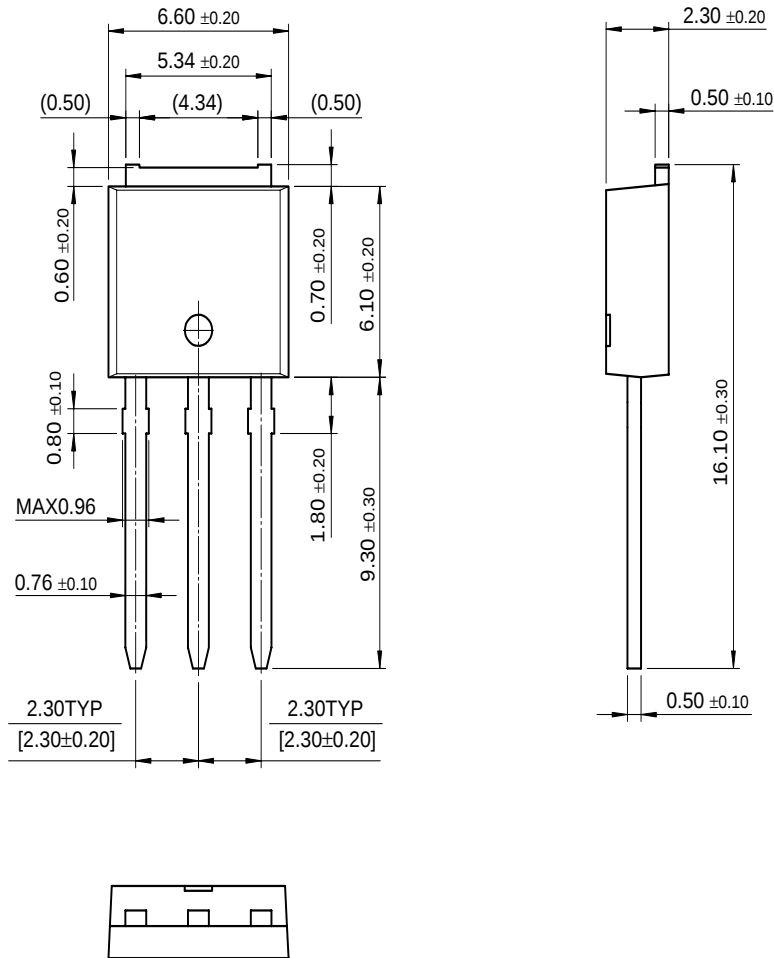
