DESCRIPTION

The 2SJ600 is P-channel MOS Field Effect Transistor designed for solenoid, motor and lamp driver.

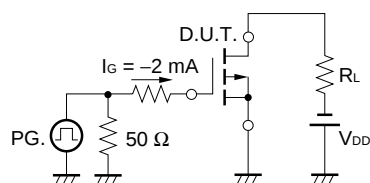
TEST CIRCUIT 1 AVALANCHE CAPABILITY



TEST CIRCUIT 2 SWITCHING TIME

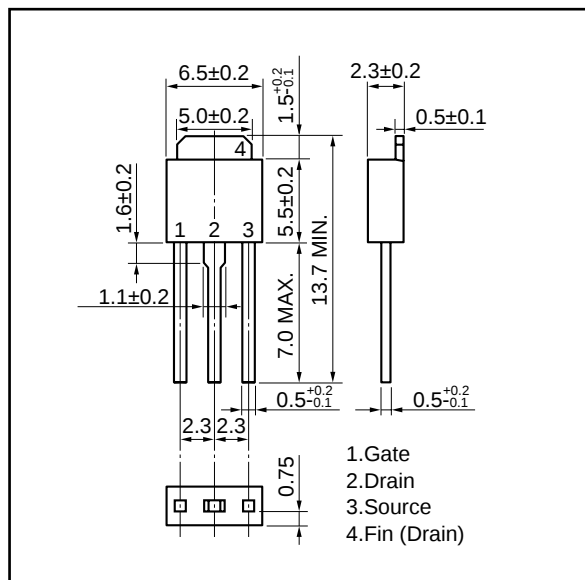


TEST CIRCUIT 3 GATE CHARGE

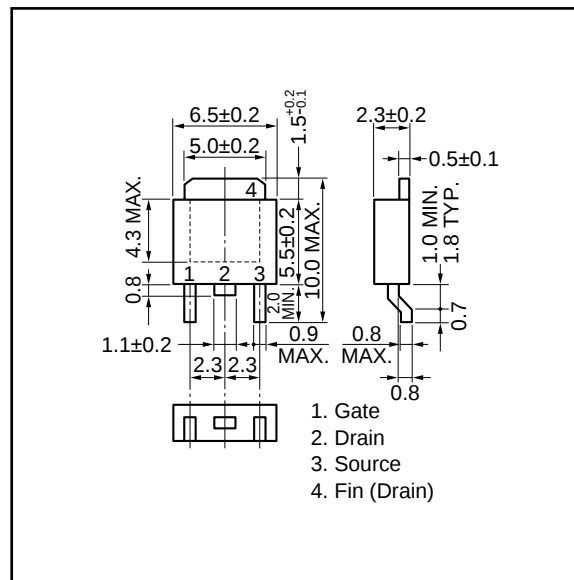

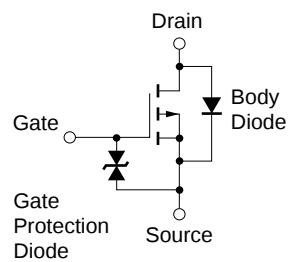
1) TO-251 (MP-3)

Remark The diode connected between the gate and source of the transistor serves as a protector against ESD. When this device actually used, an additional protection circuit is externally required if a voltage exceeding the rated voltage may be applied to this device.

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
