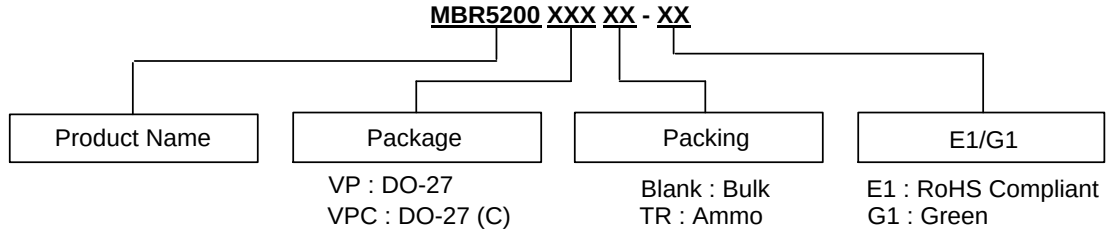

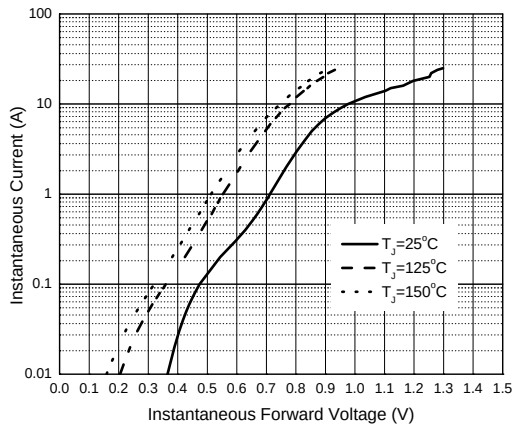


Figure 1. Typical Forward Characteristics

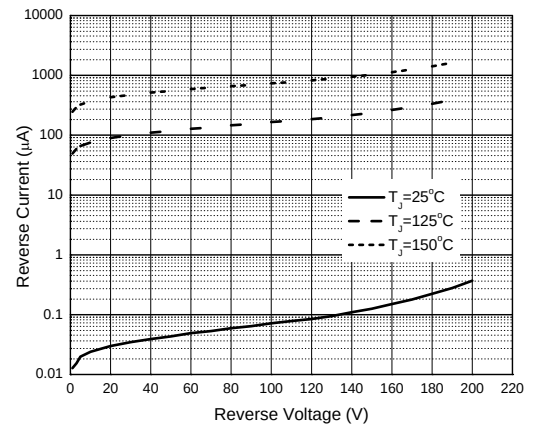


Figure 2. Typical Reverse Characteristics

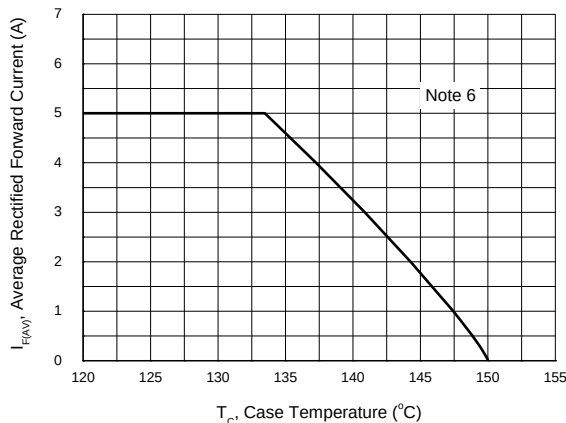


Figure 3. Average Rectified Forward Current vs. Case Temperature

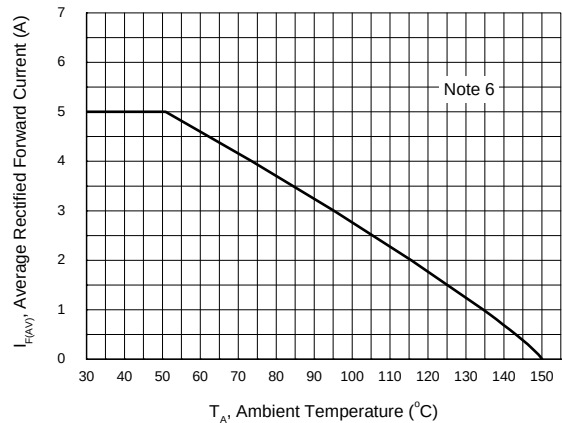
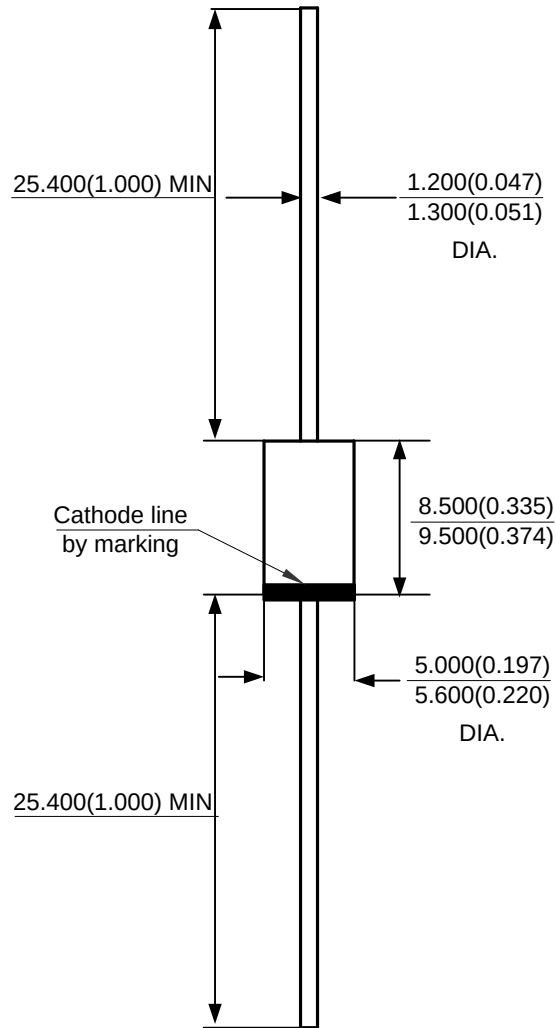


Figure 4. Average Rectified Forward Current vs. Ambient Temperature

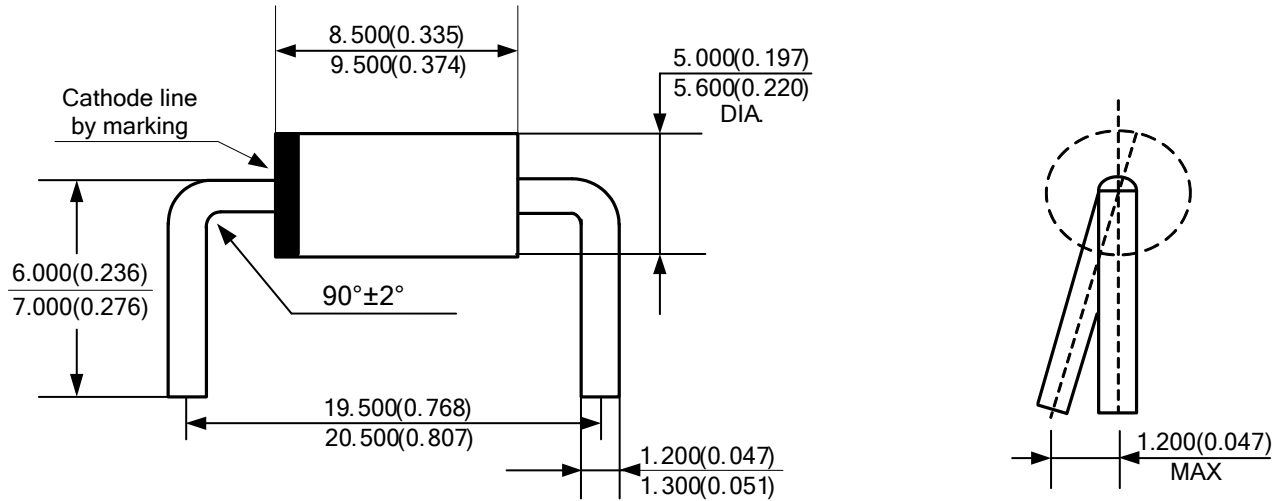
