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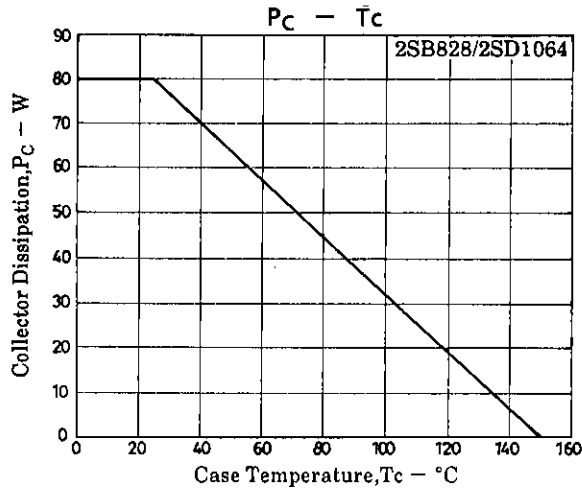
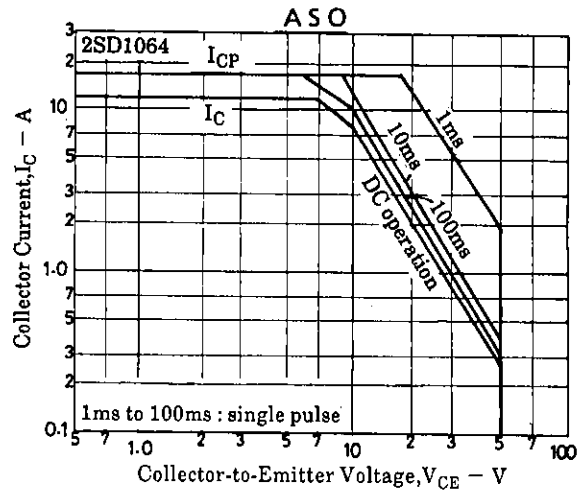
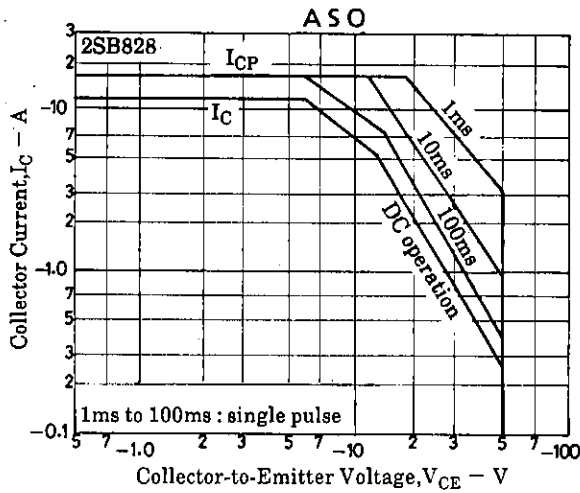
Switching Time Test Circuit**Package Dimensions 2022A**
