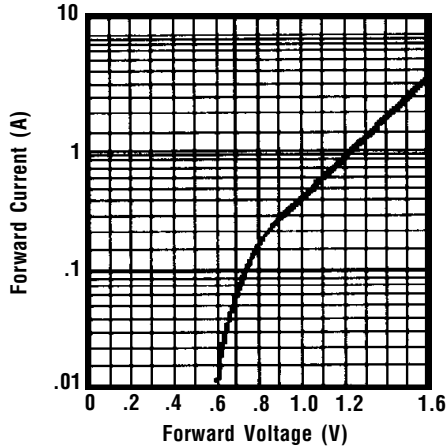

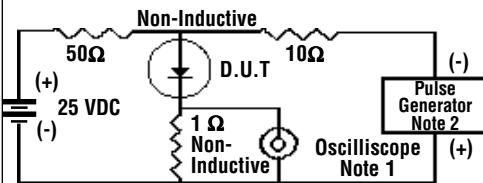
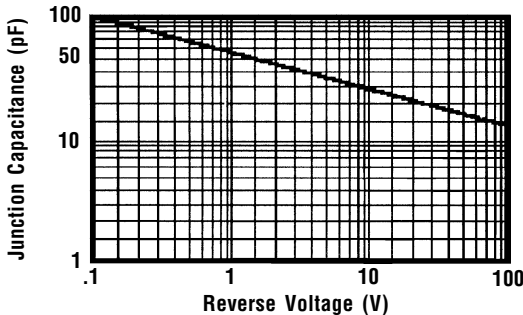
**Forward Current Derating Curve**



**Typical Instantaneous Forward Characteristics**

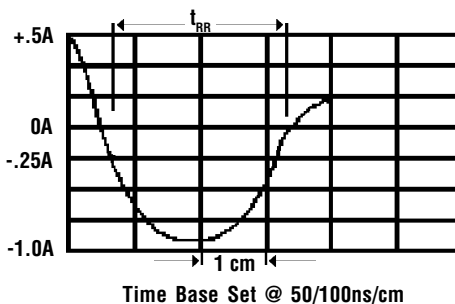


**Typical Junction Capacitance**
