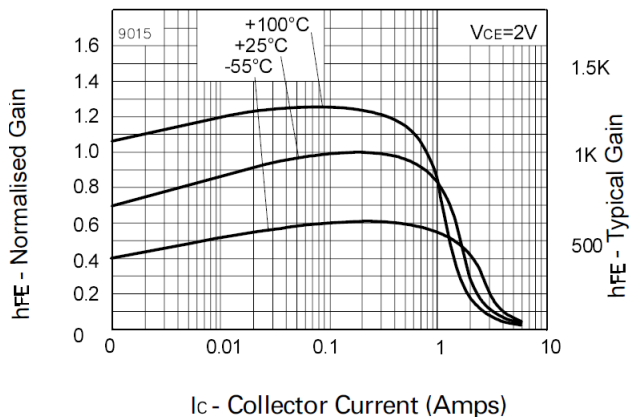
VCE(sat) v IC



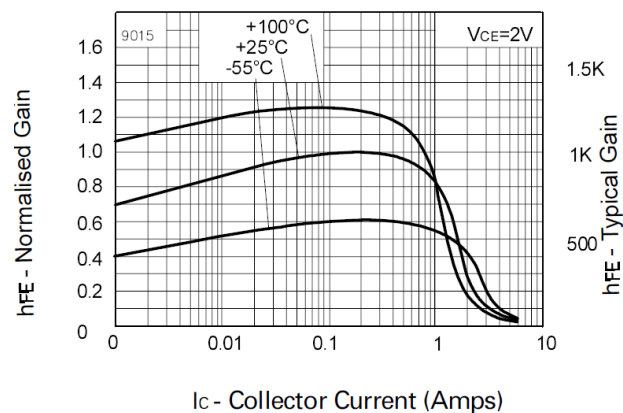

hFE v IC



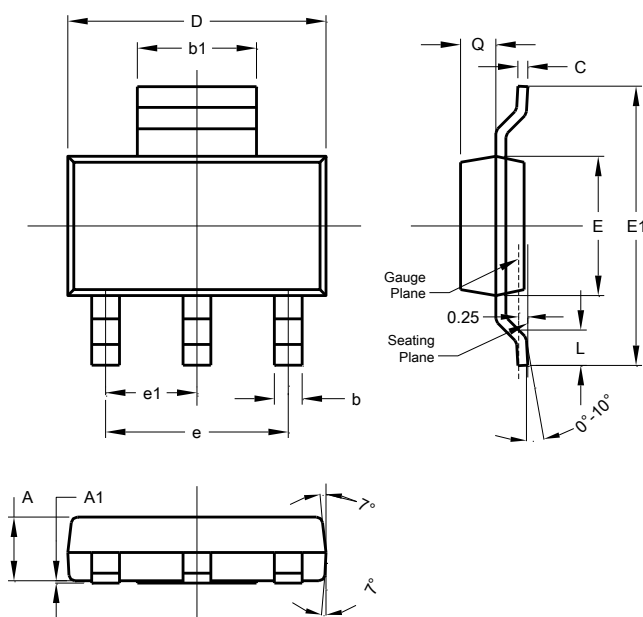

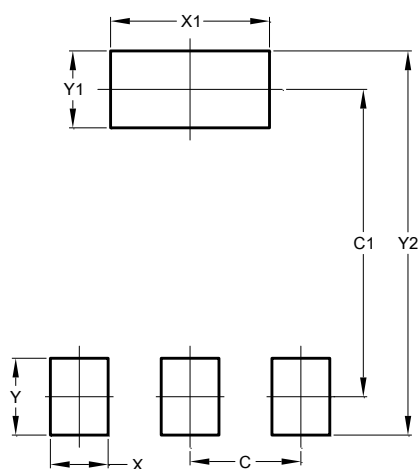
